This meeting has been scheduled by the Brentwood Agricultural Land Trust (BALT) and the Contra Costa County Agricultural Advisory Task Force to provide you with information about:

- County roadside stand/agricultural enterprise ordinance. In July 2005, the County Board of Supervisors directed County staff to draft new zoning for the County Agricultural Core to allow expanded roadside stands, value added processing and agricultural enterprises (i.e. commercial kitchens). The proposed ordinance is close to completion and you can get an update about the content and the status of the ordinance at the County Agricultural Advisory Task Force meeting that will be held on August 28 from 3 p.m. to 4 p.m.
- Buy Fresh/Buy Local logo and marketing. The Brentwood and Contra Costa Buy Fresh/Buy Local logo is ready and it looks awesome! From 4 p.m. to 5 p.m., you'll have a chance to sign up to participate in the Buy Fresh/Buy Local marketing program. Anyone on the BALT mailing list will receive a package in the mail in a couple of days with the logo, the marketing materials that will be available to folks who sign up, the farmer participation agreement and additional information.
