Attention Private Applicator Certificate holders

- New federal licensing standards by US EPA have resulted in changes to the California DPR licensing standards. If you are a **PAC cardholder**, you may need to take the exam this year. (Cardholders should have received a letter from the Agriculture Department.)
- To facilitate this, the Departments of Agriculture of **Alameda and Contra Costa** counties are hosting joint exam preparation and testing events.
- Any PACs issued prior to October of 2022 will need to pass the new exam.
- In addition, if you plant to use **Aluminum Phosphide** in 2024, you **must pass an additional** Burrowing Vertebrate Pest Fumigation (**BVF**) **subcategory exam**.
