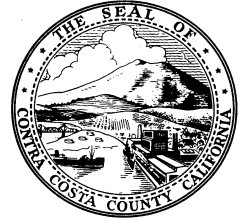

PESTICIDE SAFETY TRAINING 2017
in Spanish

New regulations require that everyone who employs farmworkers must provide a pesticide safety training for their workers at the beginning of each season. UC Cooperative Extension and the Agriculture Department in Contra Costa County have been offering a series of classes to help local growers meet these requirements as well as to promote agricultural safety in the county. We have two classes left in the series.

All classes are in Spanish and are free. However, as seating is limited, **registration is required.**

To register: Call UC Cooperative Extension at (925) 646-6540 to provide the names of attendees so we can assure seating and materials. Attendees should arrive and check in 10-15 minutes before instruction is scheduled to begin so we can provide documentation of their attendance.

Classes for Field Workers		
<i>Field Workers</i> are employees who work in fields or nurseries where pesticides have been applied but do not handle pesticides themselves. This would include those who prune, irrigate, thin, weed, harvest or do any other cultural activity.

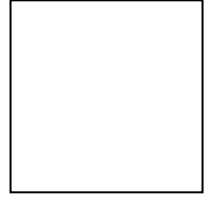
If your employee(s) cannot attend one of these scheduled classes, any private applicator or certified commercial applicator (PCA, PCO, QAC, QAL) or Qualified Instructor may legally provide the training. Anyone can become a Qualified Instructor by attending an approved training such as those offered by UC IPM and Ag Safe. If you are a larger employer, having a Qualified Instructor on staff may be the best option so they can train your workers at a time that is most convenient for your operation.
